Trip Itinerary

Day 1 Dublin | EPIC The Irish Emigration Museum | Welcome

Your Irish tour begins 2:00 PM at your Dublin hotel. Tour EPIC The Irish Emigration Museum with your knowledgeable tour guide, and discover the stories of the men and women who left Ireland and the culture they brought with them. In the evening, enjoy a welcome drink with your group before dining independently.

Day 3 Clonmacnoise Monastic Site | Galway

Journey across rolling pastures to visit the ancient monastic site of Clonmacnoise. Head to Galway for a relaxing cruise beautiful Lough Corrib, and savor an Irish coffee as you watch an Irish dancing demonstration (seasonal). Enjoy free time before dinner to browse the specialty stores, cafés, and pubs in the lively city of Galway. (B. D)

Day 5 South Pole Inn | Dingle

Head to the Dingle Peninsula, where you'll visit the South Pole Inn, home of the Antarctic explorer Tom Crean. Take the Slea Head Drive to view the stunning coastal scenery, then enjoy free time in the charming town of Dingle. Enjoy a cozy dinner at Finnegans back in Tralee. (B, D)

Day 7 South Wales | Cardiff

Travel by ferry from Rosslare to Pembroke Dock in South Wales. Journey through the countryside to Cardiff, the capital of Wales. Tour Cardiff Castle, built in Roman times and transformed into an elaborate Gothic-style residence in the 19th century. Enjoy a fun Welsh evening with dinner and entertainment. (B, D)

Day 9 London Tour | Tower of London

Tour London to see the famous landmarks, including Piccadilly Circus, Trafalgar Square, Westminster Abbey, Big Ben, and the Houses of Parliament. Visit the Tower of London to see the fortress, the Beefeaters in their distinctive uniforms, the ravens, and the Crown Jewels. The afternoon and evening are free to explore and dine on your own. (B)

Day 11 Tour Ends in London

Day 2 Dublin Tour | Taylors Three Rock Pub

Tour Dublin with a local guide to see the spacious Georgian squares and streets, landmark public buildings, and graceful townhouses. Visit St. Patrick's Cathedral, founded in 1191. The afternoon is free to explore on your own. Head to Taylors Three Rock Pub for dinner followed by a show with Irish music and dance. (B, D)

Day 4 Cliffs of Moher | Tralee

Stop at a farm to watch trained dogs herd sheep and enjoy tea with scones. Travel through the Burren to visit the Cliffs of Moher, soaring high above the Atlantic Ocean. Ferry across the River Shannon Estuary and head to Tralee. (B, D)

Day 6 Blarney Castle | Waterford Crystal | Waterford Tour

Visit Blarney Castle to kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence" or stroll the gardens. Then travel along the coast to Waterford to witness the creation of crystal masterpieces at the House of Waterford Crystal. Take a walking tour of Waterford City with local guide, exploring its Viking and Norman heritage, before dinner. (B, D)

Day 8 Roman Baths | Stonehenge

Take a panoramic drive around Cardiff. Visit Bath, the city known for its natural, mineral-rich hot springs and tour the Roman Baths, popular for more than 2,000 years. On Salisbury Plain, view the prehistoric circle of vast stone monoliths at Stonehenge. Continue to London, where you'll enjoy a free evening. (B)

Day 10 London Sightseeing

Enjoy a day of sightseeing in sightseeing in London with your voucher for a Hop-On, Hop-Off bus tour. Enjoy a farewell dinner at your hotel. (B, D)
